In 2002, InSystems Technologies was purchased by a publicly traded company, and in 2004 he founded Rusty's Best Corporation where he created and produced a unique line of Bloody Mary Mixes and grew the distribution to span seven states.

In early 2015 Russ became Managing Director of a London based startup for Interactive Achievement, LLC, a US based K-12 online testing and assessment software company. Returning to Roanoke in May 2016 after a successful sale of the company, Russ became the president of Common Wealth Growth, a private equity investment group where he is responsible for deal flow and overall company management. Russ has served his community by serving on numerous boards including the Roanoke Blacksburg Technology Council, VWCC Educational Foundation, the Foundation for Roanoke Valley, the Taubman Museum of Art, and numerous other non-profit organizations.
